NUEPA LIBRARY

The library of the National University has been acting as a crucial resource and learning centre to meet the information needs of its clientele, including faculty/staff members of the university, research scholars from India and abroad, M.Phil and Ph.D scholars of the National University, participants of various national/international training/diploma programmes organized by the National University, and other visiting faculty and users.

The library is equipped with modern teaching and learning aids, computer facilities and electronic facilities such as WI-Fi. All in-house activities in the Library, including Acquisition, Cataloguing, Circulation and Serials Control are fully computerized using the latest version of the Libsys7 Software Package.

Service Hours

The library remains open from Monday to Saturday. The service hours of the library are as follows:

Monday to Friday: 9.00 A.M to 8.00 P.M

Saturday: 10.00 A.M to 5.00 P.M

Collection

Collection development is a core activity of the library. It has undergone remarkable changes in the last decade due to increasing demands of users for e-resources. The NUEPA library has also changed its collection development strategy. The library currently subscribes to over 80% of its journals in both print and online formats. However, the books are still preferred in print only.

The NUEPA library has a rich collection of books, journals, and e-resources on educational planning and management. Besides, library also has a good country collection of books in the areas of education and its allied disciplines. The library subscribes to more than 250 current national and international journals and popular reading magazines.

E-Resources

The library has more than 125 e-journals and 5 full text e-databases from a number of reputed publishers. Besides, the library has also access to 523 e-books of Sage Education Collection.

All E-Resources are subscribed by the NUEPA library for academic purpose only. The users may automatically gain access via NUEPA's IP range. These are also accessible from off campus through VPN. These resources can be searched, browsed and material may be downloaded and printed as single copies of articles as is done in the case of printed library material.

DELNET Database

DELNET has been established with the prime objective of promoting resource sharing among the libraries through the development of a network of libraries.

The NUEPA library is a member of Delnet to promote the sharing of resources at the national and international level.

Online Information Services

1. News Flash (Press Clippings)

The NUEPA library introduced a new service as "News Flash" in 2013. It provides latest news and information on the educational sector. It is basically a press clipping service. All the newspapers (online version) are scanned by the librarian. These clipping are categorized by subject wise and send to the all faculty members through email on a daily basis.

2. NUEPA in the Press

The NUEPA library also introduced a new service as “NUEPA in the Press” in 2014. It provides press coverage on NUEPA’s recent activities, events, and miscellaneous items to the faculty by email.

3. SDI (Circulation of academic work of the NUEPA faculty)

This service provides the information about the published article, interview and book review of the NUEPA faculty members to its users through email.

4. New Arrivals

This is a new information service launched by the NUEPA library in 2014. The main aim of this service is to inform the users about new acquisitions in the library. It is monthly basis. Under this service, all newly arrived books are arranged by broad subject headings in a list form and send to the faculty. All listed books are displayed for one month.

WEB OPAC

Web OPAC can be accessed Intranet and Internet, either directly using computers connected to the LAN in the NUEPA or through the Internet using the Web OPAC on the website of NUEPA through the URL: <http://192.168.1.78:8080/jopacv11/html/SearchForm>
