

Note: In case the candidate wants to change the category for the application of a specific job postcode, they need to click on the **Change Category** button and select the required category.

• Candidates need to select the appropriate qualification pattern from the drop-down given, which has options for the qualification type.

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• In the Salient features of your Ph.D. research work section, you need to enter a short description of your research work on which you had done a Ph.D. The description should not extend more than 100 words.

- The next section is Whether Qualified UGC/CSIR NET/JRF. If you have qualified CSIR NET
 which is conducted by the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research, or UGC NET Exam
 which is conducted by the University Grant Commission, then select the appropriate option from
 the dropdown box.
 - NET with JRF If you have qualified National Eligibility Test (NET) with Junior Research Fellowship (JRF) select this option.
 - o **NET -** If you have only qualified National Eligibility Test (NET) then select this section.
 - SLET/SET If you have qualified State Level Eligibility Test (SLET) or State Eligibility Test
 (SET) then select this section.
 - None If you have not qualified for any exam, select this section.
- Next, select the subject in which you qualified for the NET exam from the dropdown menu.
- Now enter Certificate No./Roll No. of your exam.
- Then click on **Save** to add the updates.


