

Orientation Programme in Planning and Management of School Finances (December 9-13, 2013)

Background

As the problem of finances for education becomes an increasingly important issue, better planning and efficient management of finances assume utmost importance. Realising this problem, the National University of Educational Planning and Administration has been organizing an Orientation Programme in the Planning and Management of School Finances for several years. The Programme is both generic in nature and specific in content. This year the programme is being organized during December 9-13, 2013 in NUEPA, New Delhi.

Objective of the Programme:

- To sensitize the participants to the emerging problems of financing education in India;
- To enable the participants to appreciate the role of financial management in the development of school education; and
- To promote an awareness of techniques of modern financial planning and management, including cost analysis, expenditure analysis, budget analysis etc.

- Finance Commission and education
- Centrally Sponosred Schemes
- Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan and financing education
- State government financing of elementary education
- Resources for the Right to Education Bill
- Costs of education: concept and methods of estimation

- Sources of finances for education and mobilization of additional resources
- External resources for education
- Budgetary methods in education
- Utilization of resources in education
- Other methods of financial management in education including auditing and accounting methods.

Participants

Secretaries/ Joint Secretaries, Directors/ Joint Directors, Planning and Finance Officers and other senior officers dealing with the financial aspects of education in education departments of Education and Planning in the states/Uts and the central government.

Funding

NUEPA does not charge any fees for the programme. Travel assistance is provided to the participants. TA is restricted to **lowest Economy Air fare/ Apex fare by Air India** only in the shortest route to the officers who are eligible for air travel. **Travel costs by other airlines will not be reimbursed**. Those officers who are not eligible for air travel, NUEPA will pay train fare as per rules. **TA will be paid only to those officers who attend all the five days of the orientation programme.**

Lodging and Boarding

NUEPA will provide free boarding and lodging to all participants.
