System requirements:

- ➤ An internet connection—broadband wired (or) wireless (3G or 4G/LTE)
- > Speakers and a Microphone built-in (or) USB plug-in
- ➤ A Webcam built-in (or) USB plug-in
- ➤ Any standard **Desktop / Laptop** Windows (or) MAC Operating System
- Any iOS, iPad, Android **Smartphones** (or) Tabs.

To Start a Google Meet (for Candidates)

To join the Google Meet (for Candidates) with any Standard Web Browser

- > Open Gmail
- ➤ Click **Joining Code/ link** shared by NIEPA
- ➤ The Meet application will Open Automatically and Click "Join Meeting" button
- ➤ Allow access to the **GMeet** App to use the system **Camera and Mic**
- Ensure Webcam, Microphone are Functional for Two Way Communication.
- > Avod Clicking "Present Now "Button
- > Click 'Leave Call' button to leave the Meeting

To join the Google Meet (for Participants) with Smartphone using "Meet"app

- ➤ Install the "Hangout Meet" from Google Play store Click " Open" and follow the on screen instructions
- > Select your "Gmail" user id [One time Only] and the system will sign in automatically
- ➤ Go to the mail and click the "Meeting Code/Link" received in the mail account.

- ➤ Select the "Meet" to get connected and Click "Join Meeting" button
- ➤ The Virtual Meeting with Facilitators and Concerned Team will appear on the screen . Ensure **Webcam**, **Microphone** are Functional for **Two Way Communication**
