Admission to Ph. D. Programme, 2007-08

The National University of Educational Planning and Administration (NUEPA), established and fully maintained by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, is a premier organization of its own kind in South Asia. It deals with research and training in educational planning and administration encompassing all stages of education.

NUEPA offers both **full-time and part-time Ph. D. programmes** in educational policy, planning, finance and administration from a broader inter-disciplinary social science perspective. Besides, the focussed areas of research will cover school education, higher education, inclusive education, constitutional rights & law, management information system, etc. from both national & international development perspectives.

Eligibility and Application Process

- A candidate seeking admission to the Ph. D. programme shall have a Minimum of 55% marks (50% for SC/ST Candidates) or its equivalent grade in Master's Degree in Education, Social Sciences, Sciences, Commerce, Management, Law and allied disciplines from a recognized university.

Candidates who are yet to clear their final examination at the Master's level are also eligible to apply provided they pass the examination as per eligibility conditions already laid down.

- NET qualified candidates, who have been awarded Fellowships by the UGC-CSIR, with the above mentioned educational qualifications can also apply.
- In addition, the **part-time candidates** should have at least two years of teaching/research experience in educational planning and/or administration.

Government officials working in the field of educational planning & administration, with a minimum of 2 years of

experience are also eligible for admission to the part-time programme.

How to Apply

Candidates may apply in the prescribed form along with three copies of the brief write-up on the proposed research topic (in about 2500 words) to the Registrar, NUEPA, 17-B, Sri Aurobindo Marg, New Delhi-110016. The Application Form along with Prospectus can be either downloaded from our **website: www.nuepa.org** or obtained through a request along with a self-addressed stamped envelope (A4 size) of Rs. 20.00, addressed to the Registrar.

Mode of Selection

Short listed candidates will be called for test/interview/seminar presentation at NUEPA, New Delhi.

Fellowships

NUEPA offers fellowships (up to 10 in a year) for full-time Ph. D. Programme only @ Rs. 8,000/- p.m. for the first two years with a contingency grant of Rs. 10,000/- per annum, and thereafter, @ Rs. 9,000/- p.m. and a contingency grant of Rs. 20,000/- per annum for a maximum of three years.

Application complete in all respect should reach the Registrar **on or before 31st March, 2007** from the date of this Advertisement.
