About NIEPA

The National Institute of Educational Planning and Administration (NIEPA), (Deemed to be University) established by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, is a premier institution dealing with capacity building and research in planning and management of education not only in India but also in South Asia.

In recognition of the pioneering work done by the organization in the field of educational planning and administration, the Government of India have empowered it to award its own degrees by way of conferring it the status of Deemed to be University in August, 2006. NIEPA is fully maintained by the Government of India.

The National Institute has its origin dating back to 1962 when the UNESCO established the Asian Regional Centre for Educational Planners and Administrators which later became the Asian Institute of Educational Planning and Administration in 1965. After 4 years of its existence, it was taken over by the Government of India and renamed as the National Staff College for Educational Planners and Administrators. Subsequently, with the increased roles and functions of the National Staff College, particularly in capacity building, research and professional support services to governments, it was again renamed as the National Institute of Educational Planning and Administration (NIEPA) in 1979.

About Unit for International Co-Operation (UIC)

Unit for International Co-operation (UIC) is being established as a unit in NIEPA in close collaboration with the International Co-operation Division of MHRD. The Unit is established in a project mode initially for a period of 3 years. The Unit will report directly to the Vice-Chancellor.

Functions

1. To analyze and document trends and patterns in international cooperation between India and other countries, bilateral and multilateral agencies in the field of education.
2. To help preparing background documents and briefs for official participation in the meetings in the area of international cooperation in education.
3. To coordinate and strengthen India's network activities with inter-governmental, bilateral and multi-lateral agencies of cooperation in education.

The Unit has temporary positions to be filled up on immediate basis:

Deputy Advisors (No. of Posts: 03) – Consolidated salary of ` 1,00,000/- per month

Essential Qualification:

Master's Degree in Social Sciences with a minimum of 55% marks.

Desirable Qualification:

A Doctoral Degree in Social Sciences.

Experience:

Research experience in International Relations, preferably in the context of countries of Africa and North and South America.

Desirable Experience:

2 to 3 years' experience of working in International NGOs/International Organizations.
