Applications are invited for two posts of Assistant Professor in the pay scale of Rs. 15600-39100 + 6000 GP reserved for PWD category ((i) Hearing impairment (ii) Locomotor disability or cerebral palsy. [Includes all cases of orthopedically handicapped persons]).

Persons with Disability

1. Persons having locomotor disability of 40% and above, duly certified by the Competent Medical Board, shall be eligible for benefit of reservation for persons with disability.
2. The functional classification of disability of the candidate. OL/OA (i.e. one leg/one arm certified).

Incumbents are required to undertake both teaching and supervision at M Phil. and Ph. D levels. Besides, they are also required to undertake intensive research and training at school and higher education levels. Therefore, their specialization should necessarily fall in one or more of the following areas:

1. Education Planning and Administration
2. School and Non-formal Education
3. Inclusive Education
4. Higher Education
5. Teacher Preparation
6. Economics of Education/Financial Management in Education
7. Education Policies
8. Coordination and Policy Planning
9. Sociology of Education
10. Comparative Education
11. 'Educational Management Information System
12. Global Educational Concerns like WTO, GATS, FDI, IPR, etc.

Essential Qualifications:

1. A Doctoral Degree or equivalent published work with a first or high second class Master's Degree in Education, Social Sciences or discipline allied to Educational planning and administration.

Note:1 In case of persons drawn from administrative cadres, the conditions regarding doctoral degree or equivalent published work will not apply but there should be evidence of academic and innovative contribution in the field of educational planning and administration.

Note:2. The benefit to added years of service under Rule 30 of CCS(Pension) Rules, 1972 shall be admissible on fulfillment of all the conditions under these rules in the case of direct recruits.

- Note:3** (i) Four and two advance increments will be admissible to those who hold Ph.D and M.Phil degree respectively, at the time of recruitment as Associate Fellow. Candidates with D.Litt/D.Sc. Should be given benefit on par with Ph.D and M.Litt on par with M.phil.
- (ii) One Increment will be admissible to those Associate Fellow with M.Phil, who acquire Ph.D within two years of recruitment.
- (iii) An Associate Fellow with Ph.D will be eligible for two advance increments when he/she moves into Selection Grade/Reader.

Note: Minimum requirements of qualifications and/or experience may be relaxed in respect of exceptionally outstanding candidates. The Institute reserves the right to fill or not to fill up any or all the posts or to shortlist and select the candidates in any suitable position depending upon the qualifications and experience required for the said post.

Age (As on closing of date for receipt of application)

Maximum age limit would be 35 years (40 years in case of PWD candidates)

Mode of Recruitment:

Direct recruitment/Transfer on deputation by advertisement or by personal contact or by invitation.

General Conditions:

1. Candidates already in employment under government/semi government organization/ autonomous bodies should send their application through proper channel.
2. Other things being equal, preference will be given to Persons with disability candidates as per Government of India instructions currently in force.
3. Candidates from outside Delhi called for interview will be paid single return second class train fare by shortest route.
4. Applications should be in the prescribed form with a **Demand Draft of Rs. 100/-** in favour of **The Registrar, NUEPA New Delhi, (only SBI Bank) alongwith** two recent passport size photographs, one pasted on application a self addressed stamped (**Rs.10**) envelope of size 22cm x 10cm. The PWD candidates are exempted for payment of application fee.
