As you move forward in your journey, may the insights gained here continue to guide your work with empathy, integrity, and purpose. You will always have a home at the Adivasi Academy.

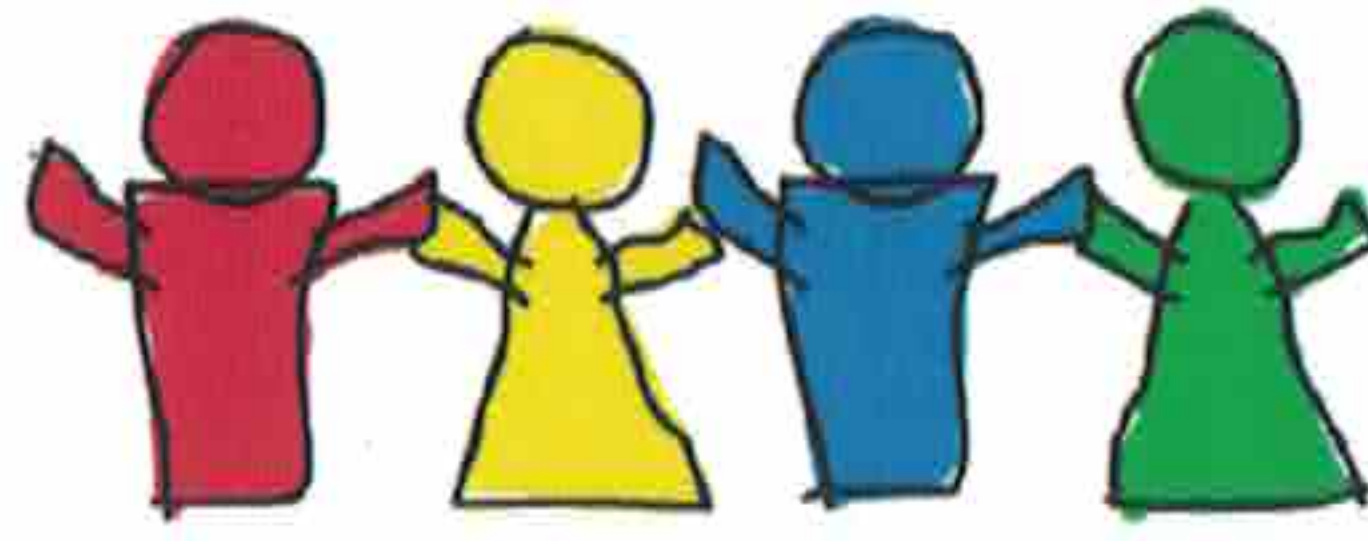

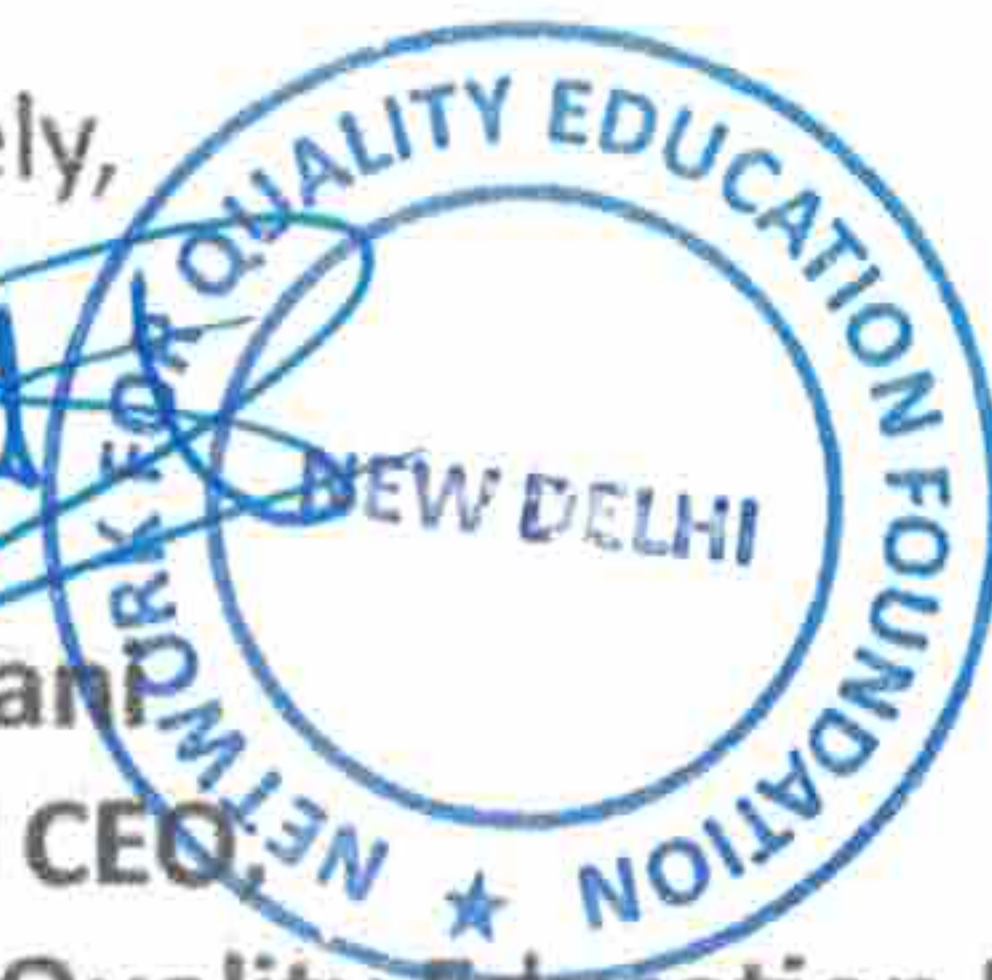
