## CALL FOR PROPOSALS

Grant-in-Aid for supporting Educational Institutions & Universities, Registered Bodies (NGOs, Trusts, etc.), Research Bodies & Professional Associations, Government & Education Boards/Agencies etc.



### ABOUT THE SCHEME

The scheme aims to support the effective implementation of the National Education Policy by promoting awareness of educational policies and programmes, and fostering research, dialogue, and innovation in the education sector. The scheme provides financial assistance as grant in aid for:

- Organizing Seminars, Conferences, and workshops;
- Conducting Research & Impact Evaluation Studies.



### ELIGIBILITY

- Professional associations (women, youth, parents, students, media, trade unions etc.) engaged in education.
- Non-profit trusts and Panchayati Raj Institutions.
- Voluntary organizations/ NGOs and social activist groups involved in educational research and innovation.
- Institutions of national importance, universities (including deemed), Association of Indian Universities, CBSE, and similar higher learning bodies.
- Autonomous bodies, and subordinate/ attached offices under Ministry of Education (MoE) and States/UT Governments.
- Registered professional bodies in the field of education.

**Note:** In the case of a privately funded organization, it should be registered under the Societies Registration Act 1860, or be a Trust duly registered under the relevant Trust Act or the Companies Act. The organization must be non-profit and be operational for at least 3 years and must also be actively engaged in social welfare activities.



### FUNDING LIMITS

- Research Studies / Evaluation Projects: Up to ₹5 lakh
- National Seminars/ Conferences/ Workshops: Up to ₹3 lakh
- International Seminars/ Conferences/ Workshops: Up to ₹5 lakh



### SELECTION PROCEDURE

- The applications received under the Grant in Aid Scheme will be reviewed by the Grant in Aid Committee (GIAC), NIEPA in terms of the eligibility conditions as well as scope and objectives of the activity.
- The GIAC reserves the right to accept or reject any application without assigning any reason thereof, and to seek additional information, clarification, or modification in the proposal as deemed necessary.
- The GIAC recommends the quantum of grant to be sanctioned based on the merits of each case.

### HOW TO APPLY

- Interested organizations are required to submit their proposals through a two-step process.
- First, register and submit your proposal online on NIEPA's website.
- Subsequently, send duly signed hard copy of the application along with all supporting documents to NIEPA, New Delhi.
- Ensure completeness of documentation as per the guidelines on the website.
