



राष्ट्रीय शैक्षिक योजना एवं प्रशासन संस्थान National Institute of Educational Planning and Administration

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कुलपति की कलम से

नीपा में यूजीसी-मालवीय मिशन शिक्षक-प्रशिक्षण केंद्र (यूजीसी-एमएमटीटीसी) की स्थापना सितंबर 2023 में की गई थी। यह केंद्र विश्वविद्यालयों और महाविद्यालयों के शिक्षकों की क्षमता विकास हेतु, यूजीसी दिशा-निर्देशों के अनुरूप विविध प्रकार के कार्यक्रमों का

आयोजन करता है। इन कार्यक्रमों में नए शैक्षणिक क्षेत्रों, अनुशासनगत प्रगति, नवीन कार्य-कौशल और अनेक समसामयिक विषयों को सम्मिलित किया जाता है। इस केंद्र का मुख्य उद्देश्य भारतीय मूल्यों को प्रोत्साहित करते हुए शिक्षण, अधिगम और शोध को सुदृढ़ बनाना है, साथ ही शिक्षण कौशल और अकादिमक ज्ञान को अद्यतन कर, शिक्षा व्यवस्था को राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति (एनईपी) 2020 की दूरदर्शी सोच के अनुरूप ढालना भी है। वर्ष 2024-25 में भी यह केंद्र यूजीसी दिशा-निर्देशों के अनुसार निरंतर कार्यक्रम संचालित कर रहा है, जिनमें सहयोग, समावेशन और व्यापक पहुंच को प्राथमिकता दी गई है।

इस केंद्र की प्रमुख उपलिब्धियों में देशभर से 4,102 प्रतिभागियों को प्रशिक्षित करते हुए लगभग 50 विविध प्रकार के कार्यक्रमों का आयोजन शामिल है। केंद्र की स्थापना से अब तक 38 राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति (एनईपी) उन्मुखीकरण एवं संवेदनशीलता कार्यक्रम, 2 संकायप्रेरण कार्यक्रम, 4 संकाय विकास कार्यक्रम तथा 5 पुनश्चर्या पाठ्यक्रम आयोजित किए जा चुके हैं। इनमें से कई कार्यक्रम राज्यों के उच्च शिक्षा विभागों, प्रतिष्ठित विश्वविद्यालयों, महाविद्यालयों और संस्थानों की मांग पर विशेष रूप से आयोजित किए गए हैं।

From Vice-Chancellor's Desk



The UGC-Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Centre (UGC-MMTTC) at NIEPA was established in September 2023. The Centre organises various kinds of programmes as per the UGC guidelines for capacity development of university

and college teachers in new domains, disciplinary advancements, new age work skills and much more. Its primary objective is to strengthen teaching, learning and research by promoting values, updating academic Indian knowledge and pedagogical skills and aligning educational practices with the evolving needs of society and the vision of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. The centre is regularly conducting programmes as per the UGC guidelines for the current year 2024-25, emphasizing collaboration, inclusivity, and expanded outreach.

The key achievements of the centre include organising around 50 programmes of varied nature and training 4102 participants from across the country. Since its inception, the centre has organised thirty-eight NEP Orientation and Sensitization Programmes, two Faculty Induction Programmes, four Faculty Development Programme and five Refresher Courses. Many of these programmes are organised on demand with the state departments of Higher Education, other renowned universities, colleges and institutes.

यह केंद्र यूजीसी के दिशा-निर्देशों के अनुरूप ऐसे प्रशिक्षण-कार्यक्रमों की रूपरेखा तैयार कर लागू करता है, जिनका उद्देश्य विश्वविद्यालयों एवं महाविद्यालयों के शिक्षकों की क्षमता में वृद्धि करना है। यह कार्यक्रम उभरते हुए शैक्षणिक क्षेत्रों, अनुशासनगत विकास तथा 21 वीं सदी के शिक्षण एवं अभिवृत्तिक कौशल पर केंद्रित होते हैं, जो राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति (एनईपी) 2020 की रूपांतरणकारी दृष्टि के अनुरूप हैं।

जुलाई से दिसंबर 2024 के मध्य, यूजीसी-एमएमटीटीसी, नीपा ने उच्च गुणवत्ता वाले कार्यक्रमों की एक श्रृंखला के माध्यम से संस्थागत प्रभाव में उल्लेखनीय वृद्धि की है। इस अवधि में केंद्र ने 10 एनईपी उन्मुखीकरण एवं संवेदनशीलता कार्यक्रम आयोजित किए, जिनमें विभिन्न विषयों के 1,154 शिक्षक एवं शोधार्थी सहभागी बने। इसके अतिरिक्त, 1 संकायप्रेरण कार्यक्रम (एफआईपी) का आयोजन किया गया, जिसमें 151 प्रतिभागियों ने भाग लिया; 1 लघुकालीन/संकाय विकास कार्यक्रम (एसटीपी/एफडीपी) और 1 बहुविषयी पुनश्चर्या पाठ्यक्रम का आयोजन भी किया गया, जिसमें कुल 231 शिक्षक सम्मिलित हुए। इन सभी कार्यक्रमों में नई शिक्षा नीति 2020: भावी दिशा तथा ज्ञानवृद्धि हेतु अनुसंधान पद्धित और सतत भविष्य की ओर अग्रसरता जैसे विषयों को प्रमुखता दी गई, जिससे अंतरविषयी ज्ञान और शिक्षण कौशल का संवर्धन हुआ।

विशेष रूप से, इन पहलों में प्रतिभागियों के लिंग-संतुलन को बनाए रखा गया, जो केंद्र के समावेशी शैक्षणिक दृष्टिकोण को दर्शाता है। सभी गतिविधियाँ इस उद्देश्य से तैयार की गईं कि शिक्षकों की बौद्धिक एवं समग्र रूप से छात्रों से जुड़ने की क्षमता को सशक्त किया जा सके।

यह केंद्र एक शैक्षणिक परामर्श समिति के मार्गदर्शन में कार्य करता है, जो इसकी रणनीतिक दिशा और शैक्षणिक उत्कृष्टता को सुनिश्चित करती है। यूजीसी-एमएमटीटीसी, नीपा उच्च शिक्षा की गुणवत्ता संवर्धन में सतत अग्रणी भूमिका निभा रहा है और संरचित, समावेशी एवं भविष्योन्मुख शिक्षक-प्रशिक्षण पहलों के माध्यम से शिक्षा जगत को सशक्त बनाने के लिए प्रतिबद्ध है।

प्रो. शशिकला वंजारी कुलपति, नीपा The Centre is mandated to design and deliver training programmes as per UGC guidelines, focusing on capacity building of university and college faculty across emerging domains, disciplinary advancements, and 21st-century pedagogical and professional skills, in alignment with the transformative vision of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

Between July and December 2024, UGC-MMTTC, NIEPA, made significant institutional impact through a series of high-quality programmes. The Centre organized ten NEP Orientation and Sensitization Programmes, reaching 1,154 faculty members and research scholars across various disciplines. It also conducted one Faculty Induction Programme (FIP) with 151 participants, one Short-Term/Faculty Development Programme (STP/FDP) and one multidisciplinary refresher course, attended by 231 faculty members. These programmes covered themes such as NEP 2020: The Way Forward, Research Methodology in Advancing Knowledge, and Sustainable Future for fostering interdisciplinary knowledge and pedagogical advancement.

Notably, gender representation among participants remained balanced across all initiatives, reflecting the Centre's inclusive approach to academic development. All activities were designed to strengthen educators' capacity to engage effectively with learners, both intellectually and holistically.

The Centre functions under the guidance of an Academic Advisory Committee, ensuring strategic oversight and academic rigor. The UGC-MMTTC, NIEPA, continues to play a pivotal role in enhancing the quality of higher education through structured, inclusive, and future-ready faculty training interventions.

governance structures with policy objectives and impact on educational outcomes.








Workshop on Four Years of NEP 2020: Initiatives towards Internationalisation at the Institutional Level, 24-26 July, 2024

A total of 77 national and international participants attended the two-day seminar, presenting a wide range of policy initiatives in the ECCE sector and showcasing how different countries are approaching the goal of ensuring quality educational outcomes for young children. The conference resulted in making strategies and an action plan for achieving the target of universalisation of ECCE and FLN in foundational education.

National Workshop on Gender Sensitisation Cells and Internal Complaint Committees of Universities, 9-13 December, 2024

The most important problem faced by the higher education system in India is the persistence of inequalities on various grounds, especially gender. Following the UGC (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal of Sexual Harassment of Women Employees and Students in HEIs) Regulations, 2015 which mandates the setting up of Internal Complaint Committees (ICC) with an aim to look into sexual harassment, a National Workshop on Gender Sensitisation Cells and Internal



Complaint Committees of Universities was held at NIEPA from 9-13 December, 2024 in which target participants were coordinators of GSCs/Presiding Officers and Members of Internal Complaint Committees of public-funded universities. The workshop was coordinated by Dr. Anshu Srivastava, Associate Professor, Department of Educational Administration, NIEPA.







Workshop on NEP 2020: Financial Implications and Resource Mobilisation, 19-20 December, 2024

The Department of Educational Finance organised a two-day workshop on NEP 2020: Financial Implications and Resource Mobilisation by Higher Education Institutes in collaboration with Tripura University at Agartala on 19-20 December, 2024. The workshop brought together institutional leaders and faculty members from various higher education institutions. The Programme Director Prof. Mona Khare initiated the workshop under the Chairmanship of Vice-Chancellor, Tripura University Prof. Ganga Prasad Parsain. The workshop provided a platform to discuss funding challenges, explore effective resource mobilisation methods and techniques, and exchange best practices in

planning and managing financial resources within the higher education sector with specific reference to North East Region.



Series of Capacity Building Programmes, July-December, 2024

The Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Government of India, has been organising a series of Capacity Building Programmes for the faculty of Centrally Funded Institutions. These programmes include:



- Capacity Building Development Programme on Specific Learning Disabilities (SLD) second cycle commenced in August 2024
- b. Nurturing Future Leadership Programme
- c. Capacity Building for Promoting Positive Mental Health, Resilience and Wellbeing

These programmes were held from July- December, 2024 and coordinated by NIEPA under the overall guidance of Prof. Shashikala Wanjari, Vice-Chancellor, NIEPA. Prof. Kumar Suresh led a team of faculty members at NIEPA as Programme Director and Dr. Amit Gautam as overall Coordinator of the Programme.

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Research Reports

Determinants of Higher Education Expansion and Strategies for Widening Participation to Achieve the GER Target of the NEP 2020

Prof. K. Biswal, Dr. N.K. Mohanty and Dr. Suman Negi submitted a research report on Determinants of Higher Education Expansion and Strategies for Widening Participation to Achieve the GER Target of the NEP 2020 to NIEPA. The study investigates the determinants and strategies for widening access to, and participation in, higher education in India to achieve the Gross Enrolment Ratio

Target of 50 per cent, as set by the NEP 2020. It emphasises the significance of education for economic growth, socio-economic equity, and the advancement of the UN Sustainable Development Agenda in India. The findings of this research are expected to inform policy and programme planning aimed at achieving the development targets outlined in the national policy.

Skill Formation and Employability: A Study of Youth in India

Skill education is a cornerstone of youth employability. In India, there is a growing recognition of the need to equip young individuals with practical skills that match the demands of the labour market. Traditional education alone is insufficient in today's rapidly evolving job landscape. Vocational training, apprenticeships, and technical education programmes are essential to bridge the gap between academic knowledge and practical skills. The present research, led by Prof. Vineeta Sirohi, focused

on four Indian states – Gujarat, Haryana, Madhya Pradesh and Tamil Nadu. For precise understanding of the skill of youth, the skilling has been divided into Formal skilling, Non-formal skilling and Informal Skilling. The study aimed to explore different modes of skill formation in the select states of India, examine the process of skill formation and study the self-perceived employability of youth and the perception of employers.

Evaluation of the UGC-CARE Scheme

The study commissioned by the UGC, was conducted by Prof. K. Biswal and Dr. Suman Negi. The study analysed the processes that the UGC CARE follows in selecting journals and identifying non-performing and fake journals. It also analysed the challenges which the UGC CARE was facing.

Evaluation Study of Scheme for Persons with Disabilities in University and Colleges on behalf of UGC

Dr. N.K. Mohanty, Prof. Pranati Panda and Sri A. N. Reddy conducted and prepared the report of Evaluation Study of Scheme for Persons with Disabilities in University and Colleges on behalf of UGC. The study highlighted an analysis of trends in enrolment of children with disabilities in higher education. It critically analysed three components of scheme

respectively (i) Teacher Preparation in Special Education (TEPSE); (ii) Higher Education for Persons with Special Needs (HEPSN); and (iii) Visually Challenged Teachers. The study concluded with a few policy challenges and recommendations.

Evaluation Study of National Skills Qualification Framework on behalf of UGC

Dr. N.K. Mohanty, Prof. Vineeta Sirohi, and Dr. Mona Sedwal conducted and prepared the report of Evaluation Study of National Skills Qualification Framework on behalf of UGC. The objectives of the evaluation study were (i) to evaluate the

different schemes of UGC in reaching their objectives; (ii) to capture the socio-economic and demographic profiles of the beneficiaries of the schemes; and (iii) to assess the impact of different schemes of UGC for serving the purpose of inclusive





and equitable quality education, career development, personal growth, and their impact on the larger society. A few recommendations were proposed based on the findings

that could be adopted for effective implementation of various schemes of skill-based courses.

A Study of the Status, Role and Responsibilities of District and Block Education Officers in Educational Administration

Prof. Kumar Suresh and Dr. V. Sucharita had submitted the report on 'A Study of the Status, Role and Responsibilities of District and Block Education Officers in Educational Administration'. The study has attempted to map out the

status, role and responsibilities of district and block education officers. The empirical data collected from six states, as case for analysis, suggest issues and challenges in administration which require strategic interventions.

A Study on Innovation and Good Practices in Educational Administration

The study conducted by Prof. Kumar Suresh and Dr. V. Sucharita, aimed at the understanding the context and efficacy of innovative initiatives of the district and

block education officers. Selective cases of innovative initiatives have been taken into account for in-depth understanding and analysis.

A Study on Employment and Employability of Higher Education Graduates in India

The four state team reports on the 'Study on Employment and Employability of Higher Education Graduates in India' was submitted by Prof. Mona Khare.
