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General Instructions and Guidelines: -

1. Interested candidate may submit the online following:
 - a. A detailed CV along with copies of self-attested relevant documents: degree, marksheet, certificates, photograph.
 - b. A cover letter highlighting relevant experience and motivation.
 - c. A brief concept note (max. 1000 words) on a proposed short-term research project in higher education policy.
2. Tenure and Assessment:
 - a. The appointment is for 11 months.
 - b. The performance appraisal will determine continuation, if any.
 - c. Appraisal criteria will be communicated at the time of onboarding.
3. All interested candidates are advised to submit their application by **03.07.2026 upto (5:30 P.M.)**.
4. The superannuated teachers may also be considered for engagement as Guest Faculty subject to a maximum age limit of 70 years.
5. The Honorarium for Guest Faculty as per as per UGC norms i.e. ₹1500/- per lecture subject to a maximum of ₹50,000/- per month.
6. Guest Faculty will not be treated like regular teachers for the purpose of voting rights or for becoming the members of the various statutory bodies of the Institute.
7. The Guest Faculty will not be given the benefit of allowances, pension, gratuity and leave etc. as admissible to the regular teachers.
8. The educational qualification, age, experience and other conditions of eligibility as stipulated above against the post shall be determined as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
9. Fulfilment of conditions of minimum qualification shall not necessarily entitle any applicant to be called for further process of recruitment.
10. Reservation for the SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/PwBD/EWS applicants will be as per the UGC/Government of India policies. Applicants seeking reservation benefits available for SC/ST/OBC (noncreamy layer)/PwBD/EWS categories must submit the necessary documents justifying the claim of respective reservation as per UGC/Government of India lists/rules/norms. The certificate uploaded should be in the format prescribed by the Govt. of India
